

What Is Required of Our Patients

- A Covid-19 Medical Questionnaire must be **DOWNLOADED**, filled out, and brought to your appointment. Even though these questions will be asked of you when your appointment is confirmed, it is required that you bring this completed form to your appointment. If you are unable to “download” this form, let us know and one will be mailed to you.
- Continue to monitor your health. Prior to any dental appointment, should you note a cough, chest tightness, difficulty breathing, loss of smell or taste, sore throat, fever or any other possible Covid-19 symptoms, please call our office to determine whether your appointment needs to be rescheduled and/or your physician needs to be contacted
- Only patients with appointments will be allowed to enter the office except
 - The parent of a minor child
 - An adult caregiver with a dependent adult
- All patients are required to wear a mask when entering the office. You will be advised when to take it off after you have been seated in the treatment room
- All patients will be provided with hand sanitizer upon entry into the office
- Infra-red forehead touchless temperatures will be taken upon entry into the office
- Special oral rinses will be provided to our patients prior to treatment
